## IMPLEMENTATION OF PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTIVES ON MOBILIZATION

As we conclude 2022; I take the opportunity to thank you for the great work you have done this year and the extra energy you have invested in ensuring that the government is felt by the people throughout the country. I wish you a very prosperous 2023 filled with success in all your functions.

However, alongside the above; I wish to draw your attention to the following presidential directives that require your strict immediate implementation and going forward in 2023:

## 1- THE PRESIDENTIAL INITIATIVE TO COMPLETELY END AIDS AS A PUBLIC HEALTH THREAT BY 2030

During Commemoration of the 2022 World AIDS day in Rukungiri District on December 1, 2022; H.E the President directed that all RDCs/RCCs should amplify the HIV/AIDS messages during their radio and TV talk shows. This is in line with the presidential initiative to end AIDS as a public threat by the year 2030. #### 2- THE ISSUE OF ENDEMIC LAZINESS AMONG UGANDANS

On December 20<sup>th</sup> and December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2022; H.E the President raised a big concern about lazy Ugandans who are not participating in producing wealth but instead opt to idle away in trading centers. He referred to them as abakongozi (time cheats). The RDCs/RCCs are directed to amplify messages that change the mindsets of the people and drawing the young people to participate in

government poverty eradication programs such as Emyoga, PDM and Youth Livelihood Program.

# 3- ACTIVITIES MANAGED UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE NRM NATIONAL CHAIRMAN, KYAMBOGO

The above is the political office of the NRM National Chairman and Head of State. The office is responsible for managing political mobilization and classified assignments of the National Chairman.

You are aware that we are serving under the NRM government and our appointing authority also doubles as the national chairman of the NRM. We therefore need to support the activities of this office that are implemented in your districts. These include mobilization of the masses to participate in developmental programs aimed at boosting their incomes, reminding the people of the four core principles of the NRM and assessing implementation of the NRM Manifesto.

You are therefore required to provide the necessary support and back up to the NRM National Chairman's Office and the Bazukulu teams undertaking mobilization activities in the field.
